<u>Classroom Discussion Questions:</u>

1. In the interview the Rev. Dr. Megan Rohrer talks about being Lutheran as a call to do good while we are living. Discuss this comment. How did/does your religious teaching approach daily life? What (if any) actions do you do on a regular basis that are prompted by your faith?

- 2. Is religion always something that we do for ourselves? Or is it motivated by other forces?
- 3. Discuss Megan's reaction to the question "What gives you hope?" They talk about heading out into nature as one practice, as well as looking at how far LGBTQ+ people have come in society. Then, answer the question for yourself, "What gives you hope?"
- 4. Megan talks about the church not being the main culprit in promoting inequality, rather the people who run it. What would faith, and communities based in faith, look like if they were as diverse as the people in a society? What would change? What would be some challenges?
